Eligibility

- The Bursaries are available to any woman who is a currently enrolled student, or recent graduate of a college or university
- Bursary applicants may be interested in any sector of renewable energy, including academic, manufacturing, technical, consulting, engineering, finance, and others.
- Applicants must be planning to pursue a career in the energy sector.
- As part of the Bursary process, each recipient will be required to undertake a mandatory shift with the WiRE
 exhibiting team, helping to manage WiRE's display booth at the conference for which the bursary is
 awarded.
- The recipient is required to cover all her own costs for transportation and accommodation the bursary applies to the conference registration fee only.

To Apply - Application package must include:

- Current résumé or CV
- Statement of Interest (300-600 words) describing why the applicant is interested, describing highlights of academic and/or work history, experience in renewable energy, career goal(s), and reasons for attending APPrO2016 and how attendance will benefit the applicant, her community, campus, and/or organization
- Complete contact information, including phone, email, and mailing address
- Letters of recommendation are encouraged, but not required.
